KidsMin Leadership Training

Throughout the year training topics include: true friendship and bullying; experts taught on child abuse detection, prevention, and reporting; selection and training of capable teachers; children involved in world missions; preparing the 4-14 Window (age range) agents of transformation; and handcrafts. It's easy to see how much this group enjoyed getting crafty

making Noah's ark with colorful popsicle sticks.



Another example of kids reaching kids was at *Casa de Oración Cristiana* (Christian House of Prayer) church missions conference. I led a workshop on mobilizing children towards world missions. While it was adults in attendance



(but with very youthful spirits!), the purpose was to motivate children to consider God's call on their lives for missions. I can't wait to see the difference these future agents of transformation will make on their generation!

Amigo Mentor Panamá

Yvonne often says it's her desire that every child from a hard place in an orphanage might have a mentor friend who first loves Jesus and also loves him or her. That is how the program *Amigo Mentor Panamá* started when we regularly visited kids to share life and life skills. For instance, two 17 year old girls learned to cook before leaving

the home upon turning 18. From our AG churches we've seen both families and single



guys or gals befriend these precious children.

We'd like to highlight another one of the faithful kidsmin workers who are helping "Children Reach Children." Angélica Ávila organized a special activity with their children's church kids by raising the funds, preparing gift bags with fruit, and then leading the service for the kids at the *Metro Amigo* orphanage. She is in the background joining the kids in this song imitating an alligator. Antonia,



another faithful leader, shared the Word. My favorite part was the small group interaction with these kids from very different backgrounds mingling, talking and praying together.

US teams

This year we had one awesome church send two terrific teams. Abundant Life Community Church and Pastor Roy Rhodes are dear friends to Panamá. In January they joined in ministering at the annual family conference for the 8th year in a row!

In June they added muchneeded full bathroom facilities for the Soloy ChildHope school among the *Ngobe* Indian children.

Family Report

Our kids got to be together recently at a friend's wedding. Chloe is an RN at Cox hospital and enjoys exercising at spin class as often as possible. Tony works in special education at the Metropolitan school and enjoys the outdoor wildlife Panamá has to offer.

Celina continues her studies at Baylor College of Medicine and volunteers at her church youth group. Gracie is studying Music Therapy at Drury University and loves hanging out with her friends.

As mentioned in our e-Mailers this year, we have been monitoring Yvonne's ascending aortic aneurysm for over 10 years. After the scan early August revealed the aneurysm had increased to the threshhold requiring open heart surgery, we scheduled it August 22 in Houston Medical Center.

The surgeon successfully replaced the dilated portion of the aorta with a dacron graft, which will last till Jesus comes. Yvonne spent about a day in ICU, then four more nights in a regular room. Chloe stayed with her overnight and helped immensely once we were all out of the hospital. We

returned to Panamá two weeks later. She continues recovering strength and stamina a little more each day. Doctors say it should take several months for her to feel 100% again.

We give thanks to the Lord for bringing her through with almost no pain nor any complications. Thank you for your continued prayers for her recovery and for our family.
